

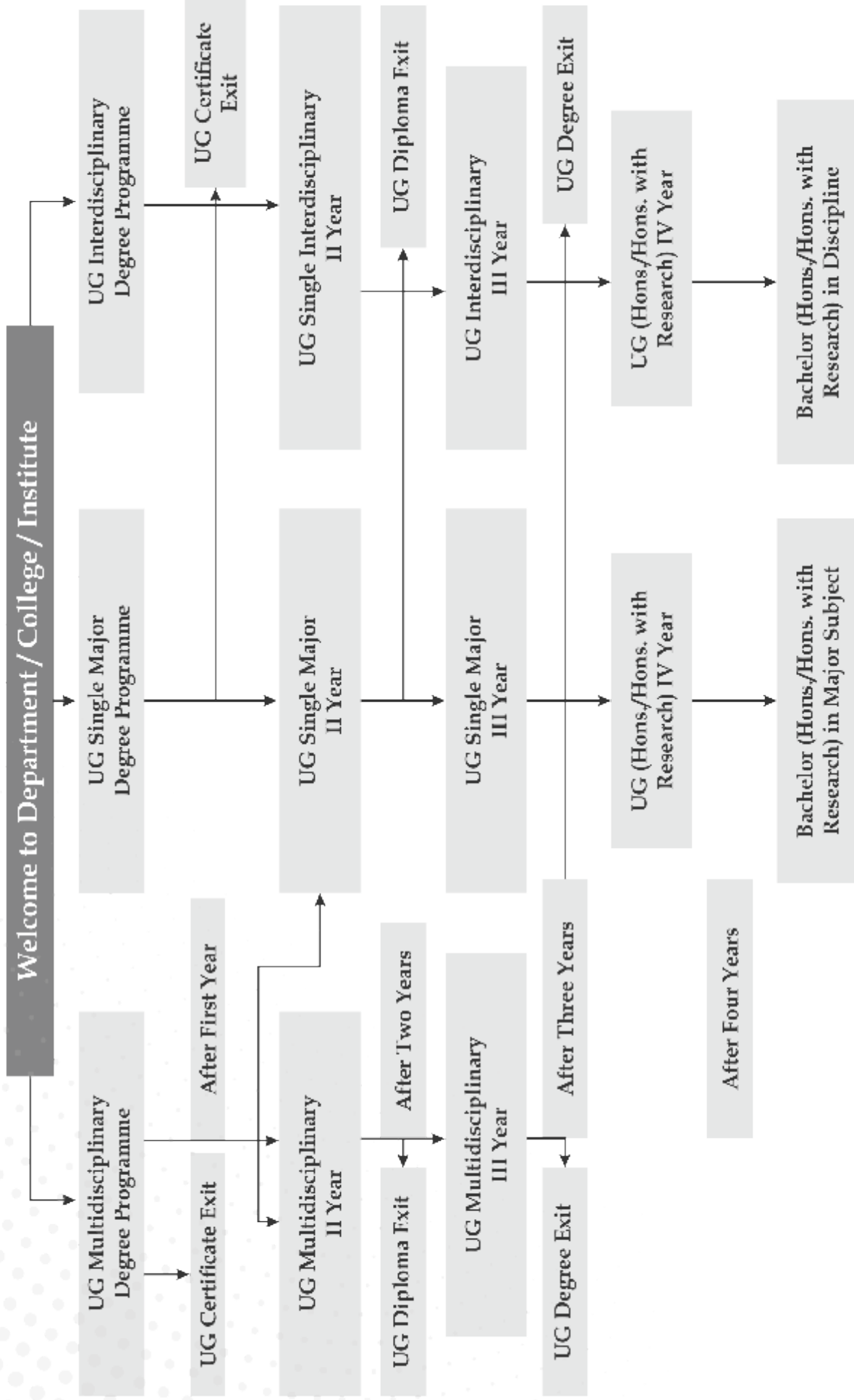

- B.Sc. Clothing & Textiles/B.Sc. Fashion Designing/Fashion Technology with 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

Bachelor's in Fashion & Apparel Design with 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

B.Sc. Voc. Textile & Fashion Designing with 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

B.Voc. Textile & Fashion Designing with 50% marks in aggregate. (Three Year Degree Course)

OR

- B.Voc. Fashion Technology with 50% marks in aggregate. (Three Year Degree Course)

Note : i) A candidate who wishes to seek admission in M.Sc. Home Sc. must register herself, by submitting application form along with a registration fee of Rs. 500/-

ii) Admission will be made strictly on merit basis against limited sanctioned seats as per K.U.K. rules.

iii) A candidate who has passed B.Sc. (Agriculture) or B.A. with Home Science as one of the main subject or B.A. with any subject combination is not eligible for admission to M.Sc. (Home Science) course for any field of specialization.

Eligibility for M.Sc. Computer Science (Software)

- B.Sc./B.Com. with Computer Science or Computer Applications (Vocational) as one of the subjects with at least 50% marks in the aggregate,

OR

- B.Sc. (Hons.) in Computer Science or B.Sc. (Hons.), Information Technology with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

- B.A. with Computer Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and having mathematics as one of the subject.

OR

- BCA with 50% marks in aggregate ; or Post B.Sc. Diploma in Computer Science & Application/Post-Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications/Post-Graduate, Diploma in Computer Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- Provided that those students who have passed one year Diploma course must have passed B.Sc. (Non-Medical or B.A. with Mathematics at their graduation Level).

Eligibility for M.Sc. Mathematics

B.A./B.Sc. with Mathematics as one of the subjects OR B.A. (Hons.) B.Sc. (Hons.) in Mathematics with at least 50% marks.
