Awareness Camp and Exhibition on Biodiversity, 20 August 2025

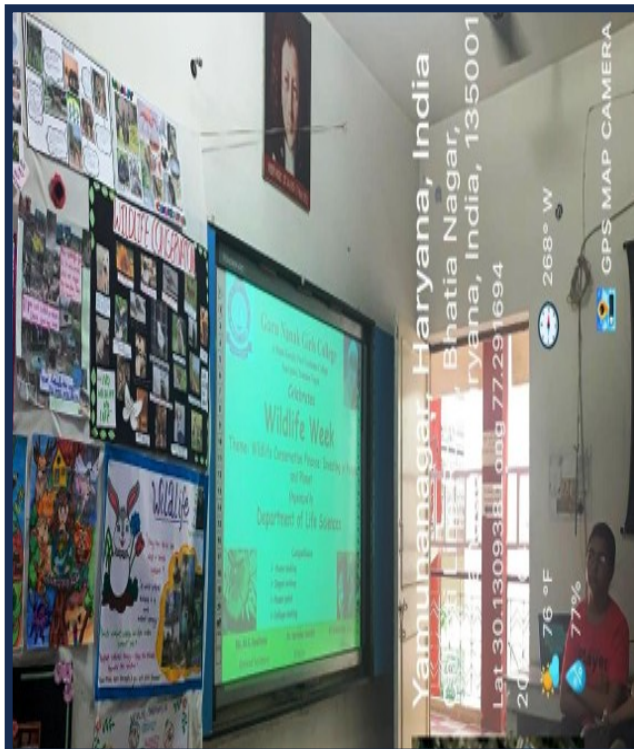
